**Kindergarten: Date: 6-11-19, Location: Enchanted**

**Forest, Salem.** Bussing: loads at YCES at 8:30 am, leaves at 9:00 am. Re-Load buses at EF: 1:00 pm, Returns to YCES at 2:15pm.

**Sack lunch & drink required** (one may be pre-ordered from the kitchen). Chaperones must be pre-authorized by teacher and office staff. No siblings allowed. Cost \$5.50 per child – \$6.25 per adult). No sandals or flip flops allowed. Please dress for the weather. We will go rain or shine.

**1<sup>st</sup> Grade: Date: June 4, 2019. Location: Gilbert House & Carrousel, Salem.**

Bussing: loads at YCES at 9:10 am, leaves at 9:20 am, Pick up time at Gilbert House 1:15 pm, Return at 2:15 pm. **Sack lunch & drink required** (one may be pre-ordered from the kitchen). Chaperones must be pre-authorized by teacher and office staff. No siblings allowed. Cost \$7 (per child/adult).

**2<sup>nd</sup> Grade: Date: June 7, 2019. Location: Miller Woods, McMinnville.**

Chaperones arrive by 8:20 am, bussing: loads at YCES at 8:30 am, leaves at 8:45 am, Pick up time at 1:45 pm, Return at 2:15 pm. Sack lunch & drink required (one may be pre-ordered from the kitchen)– **please send your child with a water bottle.** Chaperones must be pre-authorized by teacher and office staff. No siblings allowed. Cost \$7 (per child – no charge for chaperones). **Hiking boots or tennis shoes required.** No sandals or flip flops allowed. Please dress for the weather. We will go rain or shine.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade: Date: May 31, 2019. Location: Astoria Column and Fort Clatsop,**

**Astoria.** (Lewis and Clark National State Park). Bussing: loads at YCES at 8:00 am, leaves at 8:15 am, 1<sup>st</sup> stop at Column around 11:15 am. (lunchtime), then travel to Fort Clatsop at approx. 12:30, busses load at 3:30pm, leave at 3:45 pm and return to school at 6:15 pm. **Parents must pick up at school. There will NOT be bussing home from the school.** **Sack lunch & drink required** (one may be pre-ordered from the kitchen). Chaperones must be pre-authorized by teacher and office staff. No siblings allowed. There is no cost for this field trip.

**ATTENDANCE:**

**Just a reminder going into summer break.**

As most are aware, if a child has missed an accumulation of 4 or more days in a two-month window, it prompts the school district to begin the attendance notification procedure. Once a child misses 4 additional days, after the initial letter, a second letter will be sent requiring parents participation in an attendance meeting. Failure to comply with school and state policy could result in legal action and fines. We never like for that to happen, and that is why it is important to communicate with the school concerning absences.

Any child having been noted to have an attendance concern at the end of the year, is by default, automatically flagged for concerns at the beginning of the year. Please be aware of this in the coming fall.

Therefore, we need assistance going forward through the rest of the calendar year and into the beginning of 2019-2020 school year to maintain your child's attendance. If you have any questions about the school district's policy concerning attendance, please refer to your Student/Parent Handbook or contact the office for assistance.

If you have received a letter in the mail recently and are trying to work with the school concerning your child's attendance, we are very appreciative. If you have received a letter and have no documentation excusing your child's attendance or have missed an attendance meeting, please contact the office so we can clear up any concerns to avoid further action.
