Being Tardy to School

In your first-day packets, we shared the district procedure regarding absences from school, as well as information on the importance of regular school attendance for success in school. Being regularly tardy to school can have a similar effect, in that your child is missing class time on a regular basis.

Below is additional information on our procedure for regular tardies.

When students are regularly tardy, the following protocol will be followed:

Excessive Tardies - 3 or more tardies in any one month period: Phone call informing parents and students of the number of tardies.

Two months of Excessive Tardies (as stated above): Letter home and phone call to arrange a meeting with student, parent, administrator, and counselor (if needed). A support plan will be developed.

Continued issues with being tardy after both of the above have occurred: Full team meeting to reevaluate support plan.
